Converse College students use Neo in their design classes and Senior Capstone projects

Converse College is a private university in Spartanburg, South Carolina, established in 1889. It is one of only two schools in the state of South Carolina that is accredited by the Council for Interior Design Accreditation (CIDA).

Converse's BFA in Interior Design program is a professional degree that prepares students to create functional, healthy, and safe interior environments. Students develop manual and digital expertise in graphic visualization and presentation, and build an extensive knowledge base of current products and practices in use by design professionals.

Converse's senior students were first introduced to Neo during the COVID pandemic. Some of them have adopted the software for their Senior Capstone projects and some are continuing to work with it post-graduation. Converse has adopted Neo into one of their class curricula this year (Fall 2020) with their Junior students, and they plan on introducing this software to other class levels in the Spring.
