## Her E-design Journey

#### How It All Started

Tierney started her e-design business after the birth of her third child. At the time, she did not have childcare. So she realized very quickly that going to clients' homes to design their spaces was not going to be a possibility for her. So that's how e-design started, and she is currently operating her business as a 100% e-design firm.

#### Her Trigger for Change



I needed an arrangement that both fueled my passion as well as gave me the flexibility I need as a mom. So I turned to figuring out ways that I could still keep my interior design business without actually stepping foot into someone's home. When I learned of e-design in 2019, I immediately knew it was the perfect opportunity for me to take my business online and have the freedom that I wanted as a mother as well. I began my e-design journey at the end of 2019, pre-pandemic, but the desire for virtual services during the pandemic, as well as people spending more time in their homes and feeling the need to upgrade their space, accelerated the growth of the e-design industry. My timing was coincidental, though certainly beneficial.

# How She Championed a Smooth Transition

Tierney wanted to be able to manage her time exceptionally well. Because she wanted to be both a successful designer and a good mom at the same time. So she hoped to find an arrangement where she could run her business on her schedule, so that she could work mostly early mornings and late evenings while taking care of her children during the day. So managing her schedule, and then coming up with a process that would make it easy for her clients to work with her, and be able to carry out her designs for them on their own was the biggest part of transitioning into e-design for Tierney.

#### Her Fundamental Barriers

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I was already very technically-inclined as a former software engineer, so the learning curve was not very large for me. But as far as fundamental barriers go, deciding on all of the softwares that I was going to use to create a well-oiled, smooth-running online business was a "trial and error" experience.

# Why She Is Betting Big on E-design

#### **What Sets Her Apart**

Upon first glance at Tierney's portfolio, you will be immediately drawn to her lively, detailed designs that set her apart from the rest. The beauty she creates in her clients' homes and the ease with which she delivers them a space that they love are just two of the reasons clients wait months to work with her.

Her attention to detail and love for each design shows through her work in the small "finishing touches" that really pull her clients' spaces together and make them shine. "I'm a mother, and I believe homes should be, not only beautiful, but livable and functional. I work these principles into my designs so that my clients can have a home that they love and one that truly works for them."

Tierney's signature style of blending masculine and feminine energies perfectly into a space, with white walls and clean furniture lines, as well as vibrant and flowing finishing touches to balance out the space, makes her clients feel truly happy and inspired in their homes. Her favorite way to fill an empty space, without going overboard, is with greenery. She believes in white walls and having some empty wall spaces in a room to let it breathe. She loves vibrant but simple decor, and she places every detail in a room with great intention.

#### Her E-design Process

The first step in Tierney's process is to make her clients fill out a design questionnaire, so that she can fully understand what her clients want and need out of their new space. She collects pictures and measurements from them so that she can render their space accurately. She then creates Mood Boards of their spaces with the selected items so that they can make sure they are on the same page. Once the client agrees with her on the look and feel, she goes ahead and renders their rooms in **Foyr Neo** so that they can see the space completely come to life as if it were a finished photograph! Once the final design is agreed upon, Tierney hands over a presentation with their newly designed room along with a listing (and shopping links) of all of the items for their new space. It is then up to them to complete the space on their own.



My Starter and Finishing Touches Packages include item selection on a Mood Board, while my Signature Package includes a 3D Rendering of their space. I also have a Whole Home Package that offers clients the ability to have me design multiple rooms in their home at a discounted price.


#### List of all Software / Programs She Uses

# What was the timeline / turnaround time for the project?

This project only took about two weeks to complete. Because the clients were on the same page from the get-go and we only made minimal adjustments after the first iteration of the design.

Did you create a design with products available on popular furniture websites (e.g. Wayfair) or did you include custom furniture?

For this design, everything was from popular furniture websites like Wayfair and Overstock in order to keep the project inexpensive and time-sensitive for my client's budget and timing needs.

Do you have a process where you follow-up on execution or you step back once you've sent in your deliverables / packet?

I check in on my clients during their timeline for completing the project to make sure that everything is going smoothly, but it is up to them to finish the spaces, using their design and item listing as their detailed guide.
